2024 SWGA Challenge

- Year-long single elimination match play bracket
- Match Play: Two person teams best ball net (stroke off low hanicap)
- All matches will be self-scheduled by members prior to the deadline
- If a conflict or injury prevents a player from scheduling and/or participating in a match, that team must play shorthanded (two vs one)
- No substitutions once tournament begins and the are no exceptions to deadlines.
- Sign up as a two person team
- Red Tees 90% Handicap

Pace of Play: All SWGA Challenge matches are required to play their matches within the 4 hour 15 minute required pace of play time. If a match falls behind this pace, they will be required to skip any open holes and take a halve on any those holes to get back on pace.

Playoff: Any ties after 18 holes of match play will go to the first tee as a sudden death playoff using the same stroke / handicaps on the scorecard.

Teeing Off Policies

Prior to any group's being entered in the Starter's queue, all individuals in a playing group must be present.

At any time, the Starter, at his discretion, has the authority to have members play in a foursome or suitable combination of players. Twosomes are prohibited from playing during peak hours on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, unless authorized by the Starter.

Unless otherwise directed by the Starter, all play must begin at the first tee.

Practice Facility Availability & Policies

The driving range and the short game practice area open 30 minutes prior to the first tee time and close 30 minutes before Sunset. On Sundays the driving range closes 1 hour before sunset for a clean pick for mowing on Mondays.

On the driving range: Please do not hit a club longer than 230 yards or any club that can reach the back fence. Additionally, please do not hit from the grass unless given express permission by the golf staff. Drivers should not be hit on the grass tee when the mats are in use.

At the short game area: Please only use wedges, and aim all shots away from the neighboring homes. The green closest to horse farm is for bunker shots only. Please see the diagram below for details on proper practice range use.

Any members found in violation of these policies will lose playing and practice facility privileges.



2024 Men's Salem Challenge

- 32 two-man teams face off in a season-long single elimination match play bracket.
- Teams qualify for the match bracket during one of two qualifying days (better ball net stroke play, no gimmies!!). A team's qualifying score will determine its position in the bracket.
- Matches are better ball NET (stroke off low handicap)
- All matches will be self-scheduled by members PRIOR to the deadlines below. Any matches not scheduled despite mutual best efforts will be decided by a coin toss.
- If a conflict or injury prevents a player from playing in or scheduling a match, that team must either play shorthanded (two vs one).

 There are NO SUBSTITUTIONS ONCE THE TOURNAMENT BEGINS.
- If you don't have a partner, sign up as a single and Pro Shop will do its best to pair you with another member
- All matches are played from the white tees at 90% handicap

Pace of Play: All Salem Challenge matches are required to play their matches within the 4 hour 15 minute required pace of play time. If a match falls behind this pace, they will be required to skip any open holes and take a halve on any those holes to get back on pace.

Golf Cart Usage & Guest Policies

Mandatory Golf Cart or Caddie Usage

April 1st - November 1st

Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday: 9:00AM – 4:00PM Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Holidays: Until 4:00PM

Members may play with a Salem Caddie whenever carts are mandatory except for tournament play when carts are mandatory. Whenever golf cart or caddie usage is not mandatory, members may walk, carrying their own bags, without a trail fee.

Golf Guest Policies

Members are encouraged to invite guests to enjoy the golf course and clubhouse. It is preferred that members notify the golf shop prior to arriving with their guests. This will allow our staff to be better prepared to serve you and your guest and prepare our starter to best accommodate your preferred starting time.

A member may bring up to three guests any time on weekdays (Tues – Friday). On weekends (Sat, Sun & Holidays) a member may bring one guest before 11:00 AM and three guests after 11:00 AM unless otherwise approved by Head Golf Professional.

A guest is limited to a maximum of two rounds per month. This rule is exclusive of one member guest tournament.

Pace of Play

The club's goal for play is the "four-hour foursome". Members and guests are encouraged to play as foursomes to the extent practicable, and foursomes should take a **maximum of 4** hours and 15 minutes to complete 18 holes.

The golf staff and golf committee will enforce pace of play in an appropriate manner.

Fast Play Tips

Below are a few tips that will help your overall pace of play. Playing quickly does not have to compromise the social aspect of the game!

- When leaving the teeing ground, walk with your group until you reach the fairway; then, proceed directly to your ball. If using a cart, drop your partner off at his/her ball and proceed to your ball. Don't wait for your partner to hit his / her shot.
- While your playing partners are playing their shots, get ready to play your own. Use this time to measure distance, judge the wind and choose your club.
- If you are out of the hole, please pick up and take the maximum allowable score per the Equitable Stroke Control rules (Net Double Bogey).
- Record your scores on the next tee rather than on the green of the hole you just completed.
- And finally... PLAY READY GOLF!

Handicaps & Score Posting

All members are REQUIRED to post (on the day the round was played) every round that is considered acceptable for handicap purposes. It is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED that scores are posted HOLE BY HOLE into the GHIN handicap system. A score is acceptable for handicap purposes if the round has been played:

- In an authorized format of play over at least the minimum number of holes required for either a 9–hole or an 18–hole score to be acceptable.
 - * For an 18-hole score to be acceptable for handicap purposes, a minimum of 10-18 holes must be played.
 - * For a 9 hole score to be posted, 9 holes must be played.
- In the company of at least one other person, who may also act as a marker.
- According to the Rules of Golf
- On a golf course with a current course rating and slope rating, where length and normal playing difficulty is maintained at a consistent level
- On a golf course during its active season.

An accurate handicap system is vital to the integrity of the game. The Golf Committee will audit handicaps and make adjustments if members are found in violation of score posting rules. The official USGA handicaps are revised daily on the GHIN App.

Tournament Policies

- Participants in all tournaments at Salem will be randomly paired by the Pro Shop. Pairings requests will not be taken with the exception of One Day Member Guest tournaments.
- If you do not have a partner for an event but are interested in playing, please reach out to the Pro Shop to try to pair you for the event.
- Pro Shop credit prizes for each event are posted into members credit books after the completion of the event.

Golf Genius Tournament Management

The Golf Genius system will allow members to sign up for golf events online. We encourage members to use this simple process, and we will still accept sign ups in golf shop for all events.

Golf Genius will allow our members and guests to see live scores from their phones or computers to keep up with leaders' scores, encouraging fun competition between groups.



Equitable Stroke Control

Equitable score control is used to adjust recorded scores in order to more accurately calculate a players handicap. Its purpose is to avoid one or more very high scores on individual holes inflating the handicap calculation. The maximum score that a player is able to record for handicap posting purposes is defined as a Net Double Bogey. If you post your scores hole by hole, the handicap system will automatically make this adjustment for you.

Application of Net Double Bogey Adjustment for Maximum Hole Score



Local Rules

USGA shall govern all rules with the following local rules.

Embedded Ball Rule: Anywhere "through the green," not in a hazard, a ball, which is embedded in its own pitch mark may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near to as possible to the spot where it lies, but no nearer to the hole.

Out of Bounds: Marked by white stakes on holes 11, 12 and 17, the stone wall on hole 8, the stone wall and fence on hole 17, and the road curbing behind 9 green.

Penalty Areas: Marked by Red Stakes

Water Hazards: Marked by Yellow Stakes

Ground Under Repair: Marked by signs or painted white lines

<u>Power Lines</u>: If a ball strikes a power line or pole on any hole, it must be replayed without penalty.

<u>Obstructions</u>: Anything artificial, including paved roads, cart paths or stakes (except those defining out of bounds), buildings, benches, sprinkler heads, drainage and hoses are considered obstructions. Stone walls are an integral part of the golf course and are not considered obstructions.

Course Care

We ask that all Salem members be stewards of our golf course. The better we all take care of our property, the more beautiful it will remain. The Golf Professional Staff, Superintendent and Golf Committees ask that you:

- Follow all Golf Cart and posted sign instructions. Keep carts, Tempo Walks and Golf Boards out of wet areas and at least 30 yards away from greens and tees
- Replace all divots and/or fill them with divot mix
- Repair ball marks on putting greens
- Rake bunkers
- Enter and leave bunkers from the low points of the bunker.

Guests and non-members may join the camp, but members will have first priority

Proper attire is required for members and their guests. Club Ownership and The Golf Committees have requested that the Professional Staff strictly enforce dress code for all members and their guests. Some specific guidance on proper golf attire:

- No blue jeans or jean shorts
- Golf shirts must be tucked into shorts/pants
- No cargo shorts/pants
- No bathing suits
- No tank top shirts for men
- · Collared shirts are required
- Hats must be worn with the brim forward
- Proper footwear that will not damage green surfaces is required for all players. No metal spikes
- Shorts for men must be within 2 inches of the knee
- No yoga pants or halter tops
- Golf shoes must be changed in the locker room. They may not be changed in the parking lot
